Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to everyone who took the time to respond to our recent parent survey. Your feedback is invaluable in helping us address key issues within our school community.

We have received mixed responses regarding parking around school. Many families live in the local area, with a large number within a 0.5-mile radius. Notably, 41% of respondents highlighted parking as their primary concern. I want to assure you that we are actively working with our partners at the local authority to explore solutions.

I have also met with local councillor, Cllr Abel, to share your concerns, and we will continue to advocate for improvements. Thank you for your patience and support as we work towards a positive outcome.

One possible solution we are currently exploring is a walking bus. If this is something you feel you could help organise or support, please do get in touch – your involvement would make a real difference.

In other exciting news, our Easter Chicks have arrived in school and will be available for purchase after school today until Wednesday next week. All proceeds will go to Francis House Hospice, please see more details below, and we thank you for your support.

Excitement is also building for next week's Music Showcase and the PTA's Swimathon events. 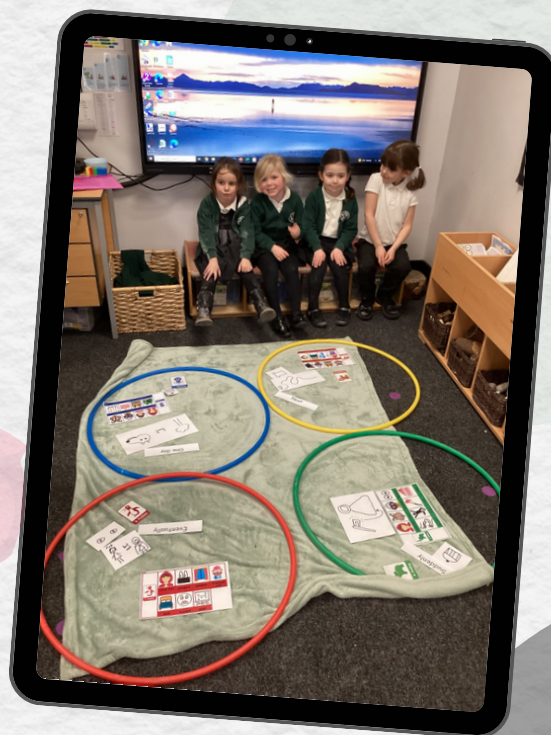
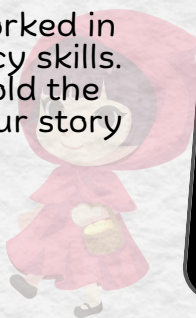

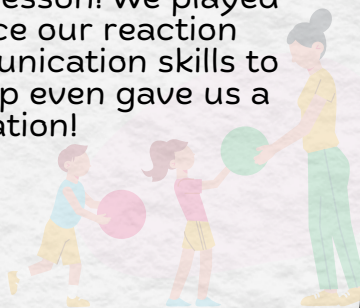
Look what's been

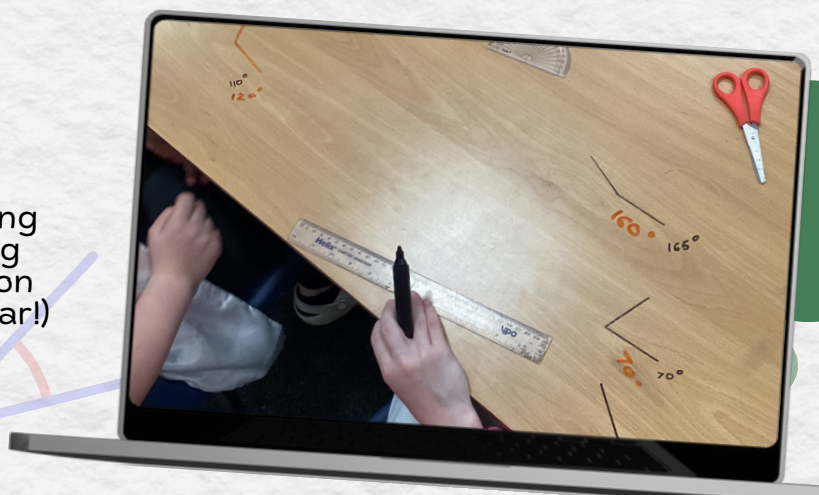

Pantry Foodbank

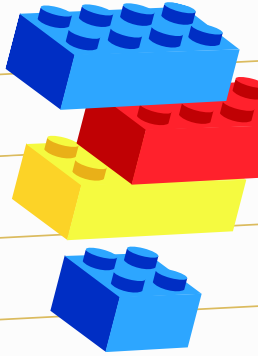
"We had a lovely surprise at The

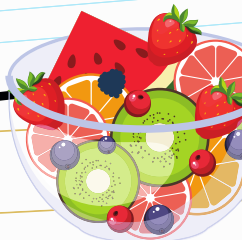
