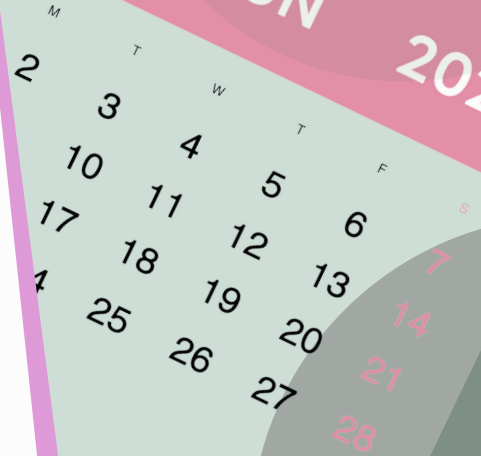

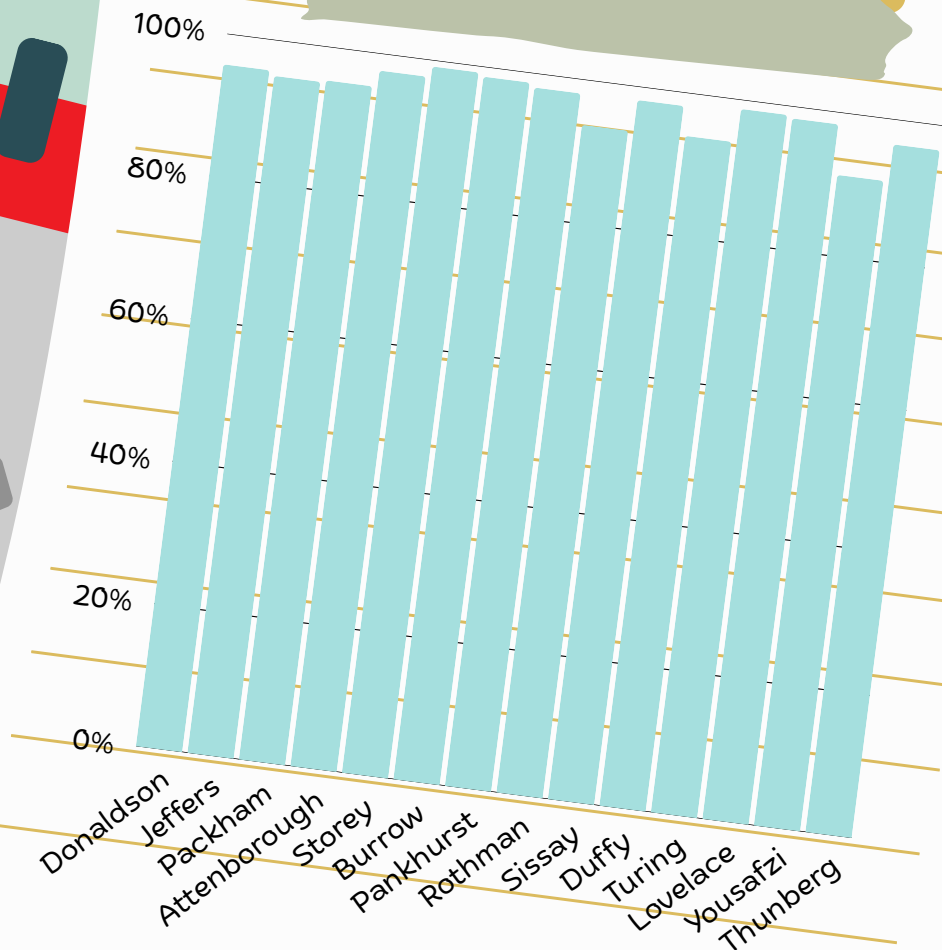

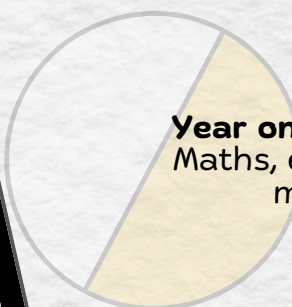

Look what's been happening in class this week!

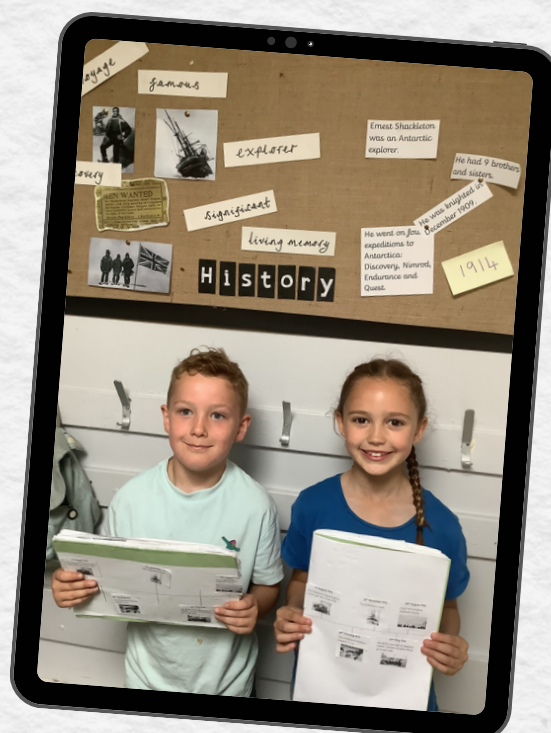
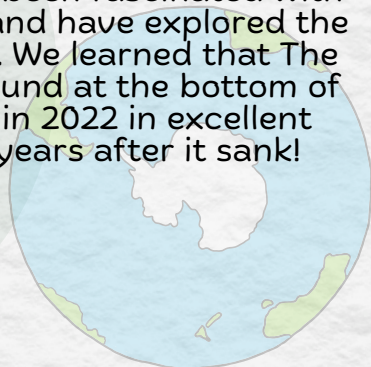
This week in **Reception** we have dived into Story World using our Magic Story Box. We met Noi, a character from our new book 'The Storm Whale'. Noi had found a whale on the beach and needed our help!



Year one have been working hard in Maths, exploring different shapes to make the fraction 'half'



In **Year 2** this week we have started to research Ernest Shackleton and his voyage to Antarctica on The Endurance. The children have been fascinated with his survival story and have explored the timeline of events. We learned that The Endurance was found at the bottom of the Weddell Sea in 2022 in excellent condition - 107 years after it sank!

Year 3 have enjoyed their first week back after half term with an Art Day, focusing on creating clay canopic jars. The children learnt about canopic jars, explored clay techniques and then designed and created their canopic jars. The children worked so hard and the outcomes are fantastic. Year 4 have been working extremely hard this week doing our Multiplication Check. We are extremely proud of all the children! We took a break and learned how to play scales on the keyboards. These will be used in our compositions later in the term.

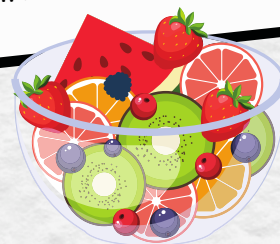
