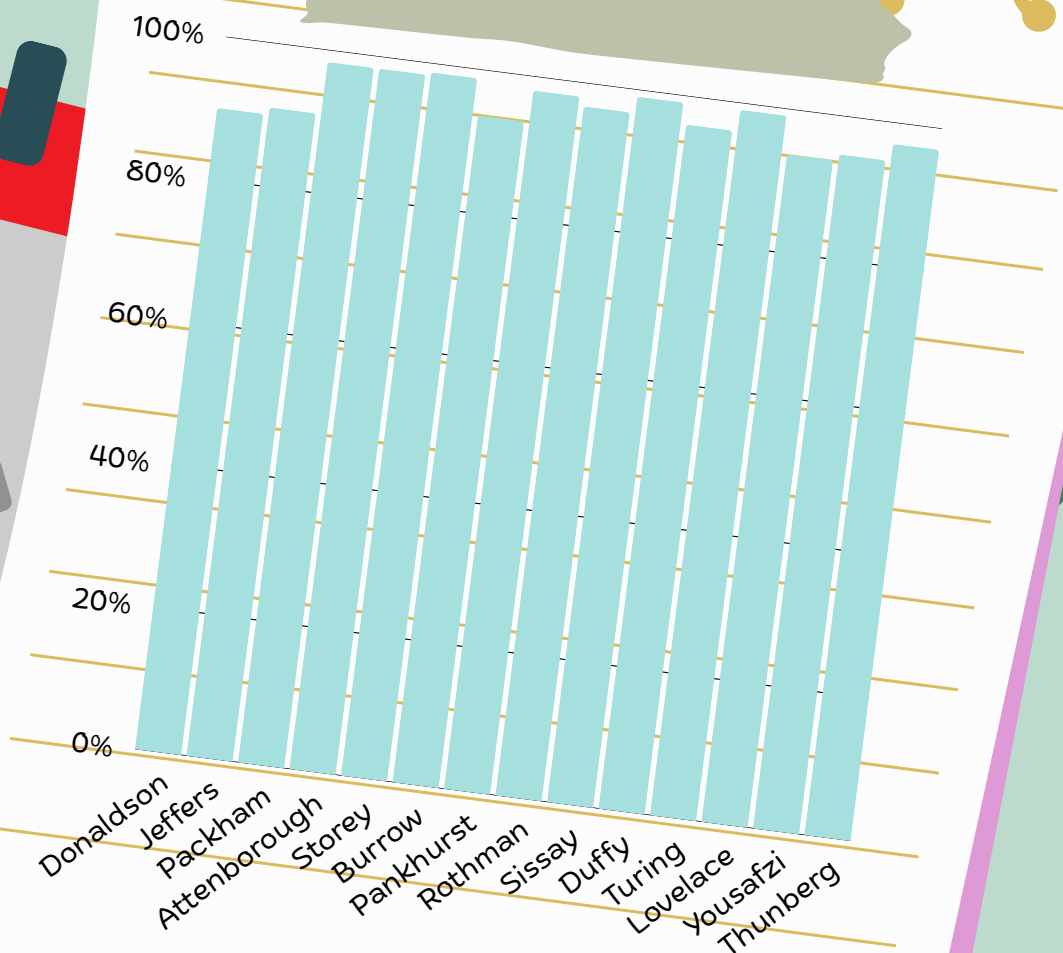

**Year 1** have had a fabulous time exploring techniques and developing our skills in printing, during our Art day on Tuesday.

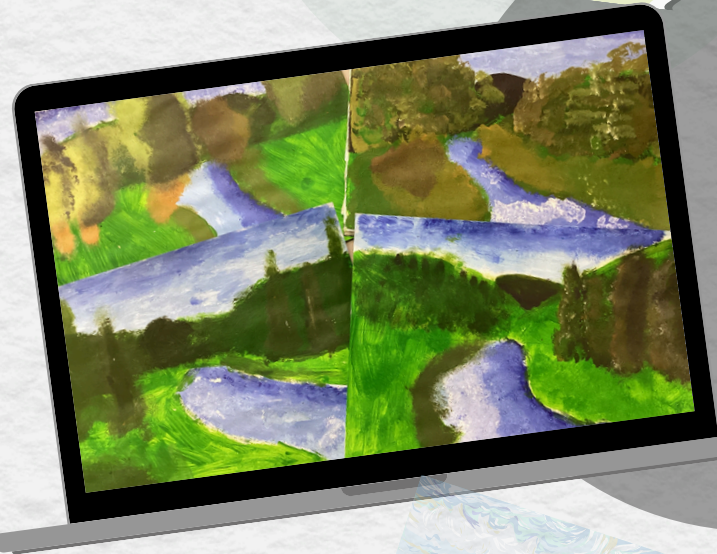

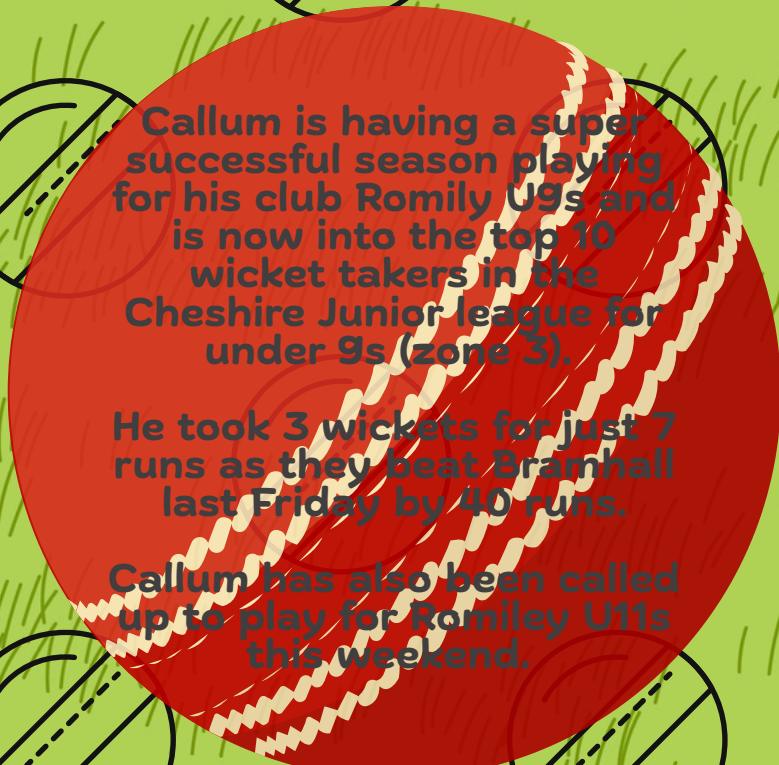




Callum is having a super successful season playing for his club Romily U9s and is now into the top 10 wicket takers in the Cheshire Junior league for under 9s (zone 3).
