



We couldn't be prouder of our Ludworth learners – you've truly shone! 🌟




NEXT WEEK

Sienna is an avid freestyle and slalom snowboarder. She currently shreds weekly at Chillfactore and has trained and competed at other domes such as Tamworth, Castleford and the outdoor dry slopes such as Halifax, Rossendale and Kidsgrove. As well as the mountains of course! In chasing the shred, Sienna switched her focus from ski-ing to snowboarding and regularly skateboards and wakeboards to support this, off the slope.

Sienna is part of the snowboarding group the "Boobytrap" and trains regularly with its founder the Traplord aka John Weatherley. John trained Mia Brookes, the youngest adult to win the World Championship in 2023! She also won Gold at the xgames at just aged 17! After riding and competing all over the world, Mia still comes back to her home turf Chillfactore and is a huge inspiration to Sienna (see picture of Sienna and Mia).

Sienna also regularly attends "Snocone social" which is a social shred session aimed towards bringing female dome riders together. This year, Sienna's photo could be published in the UK's Reason Magazine in an article featuring female UK dome riders. All organised by sponsored athlete, Isobel Jones.

This year and last year, Sienna jibbed around the infamous Absolut Park in Austria grinding rails and hitting kickers with professional and semi-professional riders. It's no coincidence after these experiences that Sienna has podiumed at several competitions, won countless medals and trophies and is showing huge improvements- so much so that she has been asked (for the second time) to join the National Squad with Snowsports England. We're all so proud of how brave and talented Sienna is. Watch this space!
