TOPIC

By the end of this half term through provision, topic, RE and PSHE lessons we will be able to answer the following questions:

- What is a family?
- Who is in our family? (School and Home)
- Does everyone have the same thoughts?
- What are our feelings?
- Where do animals live?
- How does nature change through the year?



PHONICS

This term we will learn the phonemes: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss.

We will learn to blend CVC words e.g cat, leg, as well as segmenting them for writing.

LITERACY

Through our narrative immersion approach we will be learning to:

- Hear and write the initial sounds in words.
- Form pre-cursive letters.
- Write our names.
- Segment and blend CVC words for reading and writing.

MATHS

Matching, Sorting & Comparing Amounts

- Sort objects into sets
- Identify which group has more/most items and which has fewer/fewest items.

Line items up using 1-1 correspondence and a 5 frame.





Compare Size, Mass & Capacity

- Know that objects can be compared and ordered according to size.
- Use language such as big, little, large, small, tall and short to describe objects.
