MAGIC STORY BOX

Our magic story box this half term will be the book 'Star in the Jar' by Sam Hay.



TOPIC

By the end of this half term, through provision, topic, RE and PSHE lessons we will be able to answer questions like...

- What does special mean?
- Does special mean the same thing to everyone?
- What are stars?
- What is a memory?
- How is a shadow made?
- What is Remembrance Day?
- Where do we live?
- What animals come out at night?

LITERACY

This term we will learn to:

- Verbally compose a sentence and say it back to an adult.
- Write CVC words independently.
- Write the sounds we can hear in the correct sequence with growing independence.
- Write a simple caption.
- Use a finger space between each word when writing.
- Verbally retell a story in the correct sequence.
- Answer simple comprehension questions
- Orally retell a story.

PHONICS


This term we will recap all the phonemes previously taught (s,a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, σ , c, k, ck, e, u, r) and also teach the phonemes h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss.

We will focus on consolidating our blending and segmenting skills of simple CVC words. Then we will learn new phonemes including digraphs - 2 letters making 1 sound eg- ch 'chin' and trigraphs - 3 letters making 1 sound eg- igh 'night'.

We will continue to practice reading and writing words and begin to read and write captions.

We will be playing lots of phase 2 phonics games and the website Phonics Play has lots of fun games to help children with their segmenting and blending skills.






MATHS

READING AT HOME

Phonic flash cards- Please continue to practice phonic flashcards at home. It is best to do this in fun ways (a letter was sent home with some ideas on dojo on 10th October). We also suggest focusing on a maximum of 4 sounds at a time until your child is confident with these. Please sign the reading log when you have practiced the flashcards.

Reading books-Please try to read with your child at least three times a week, little and often is best.

Please write into the reading logs each time. This will help us to see how your child is doing at home with their reading.

RR words-Pink words have been added in the back of the children's reading logs. Practicing these will help your child with their reading fluency. When your child can automatically read 10 of the pink words they will be given a pink book along with their phonic book. These will be assessed regularly and new words will be given.
