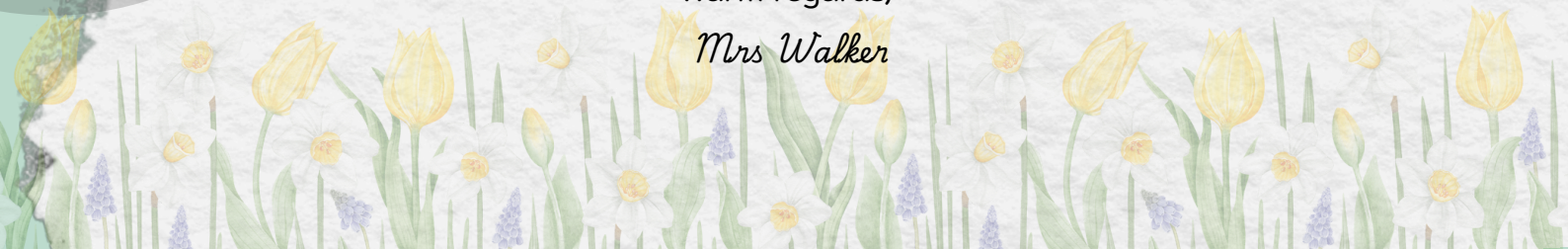
#### **Values Assembly Next Friday**

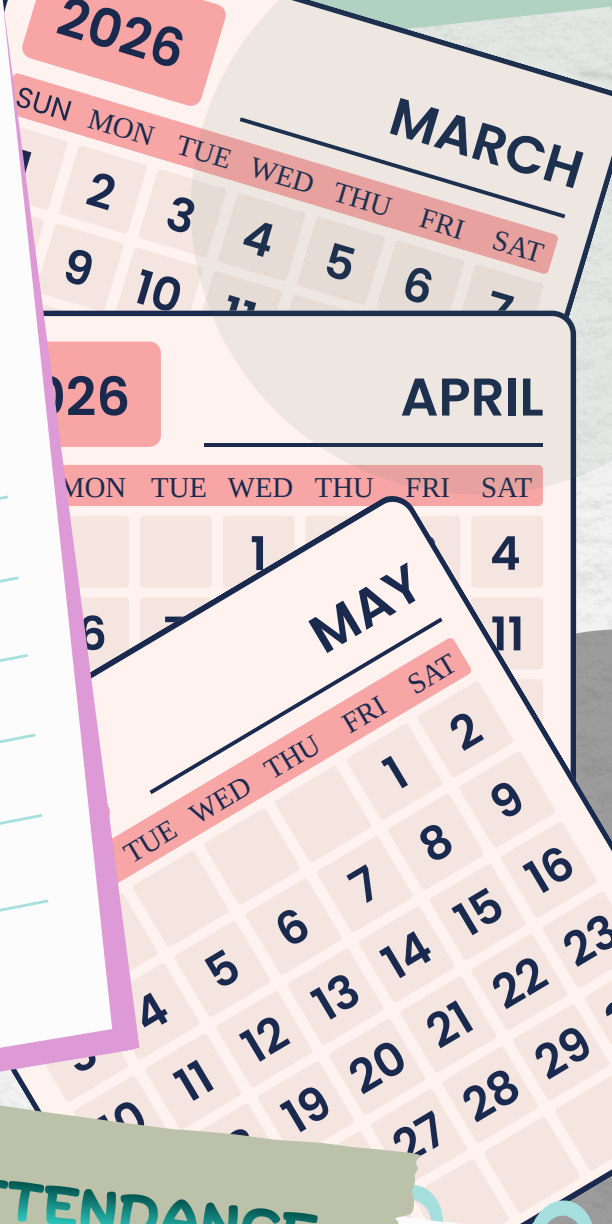
