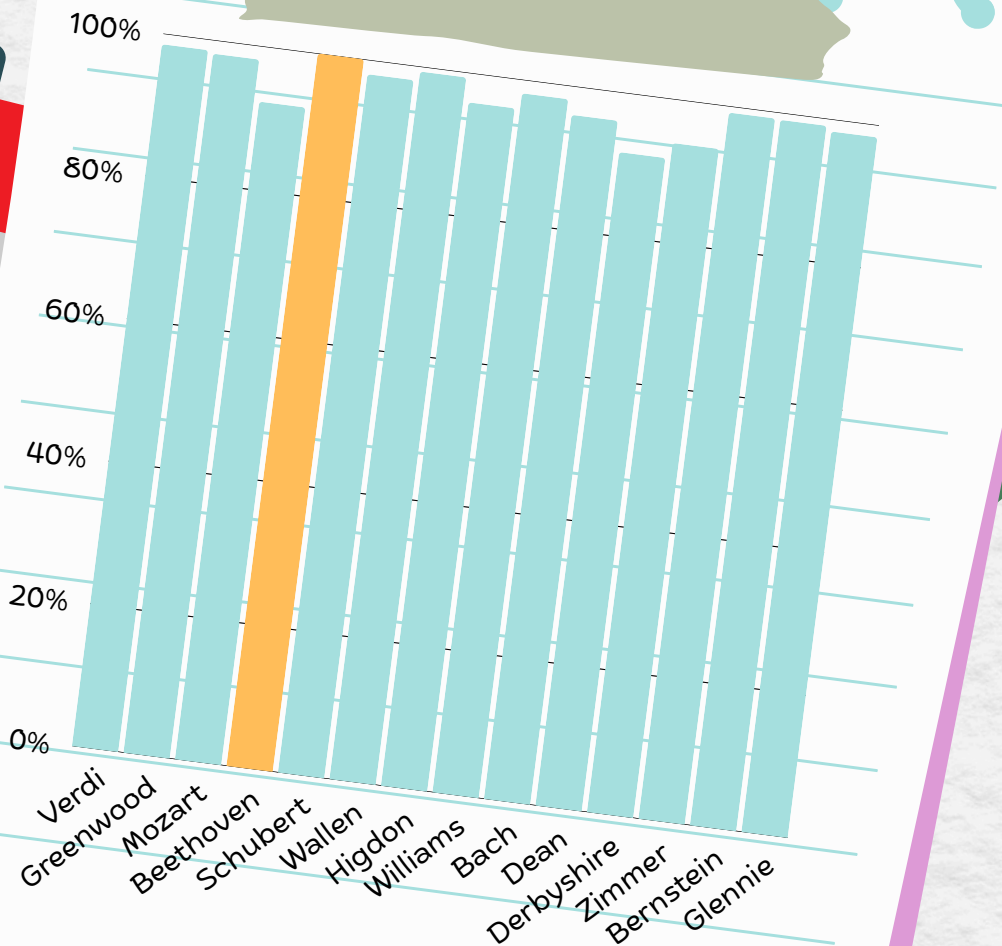

STOCKPORT CHILDREN'S BOOK AWARDS 2026



Stockport Libraries are looking for your school's best artwork inspired by the 2026 Book Awards shortlisted titles.

Who can enter?

All children aged 4-12 years who live in or attend school in Stockport and who have read and enjoyed the shortlisted books.

What type of artwork?

Anything that represents a book read from the shortlist – a scene from the story, how it made you feel...let your imagination free!

There are no restrictions on size or materials used, but pieces should lend themselves to being scanned and printed for display purposes.

How many pieces can my school enter?

Each school is asked to submit a maximum of 30 pieces of artwork. Consider hosting a school competition or vote to choose the students' favourite pieces.

How to enter?

Artwork can be submitted in person at any Stockport Library. Or, email a high quality photograph or scan of the artwork to childrensbookaward@stockport.gov.uk.

Please include the child(ren)'s full name, age, which school they attend and which book the artwork represents.

The deadline for entry is Sunday, **May 24th 2026**.

What are the prizes?

Winners will be notified via school or via parent contact details if submitted independently from schools.

1st Prize – Win your height in books!

2nd Prize – £150 of books

3rd Prize – £100 of books

Runners up – a piece of artwork representing each of the nominated books will be selected to be framed and presented to the authors and the artist.

All winners and runners up will win tickets to the Book Awards Presentation Evening at Stockport Town Hall Ballroom on Monday, 6th July 2025.
