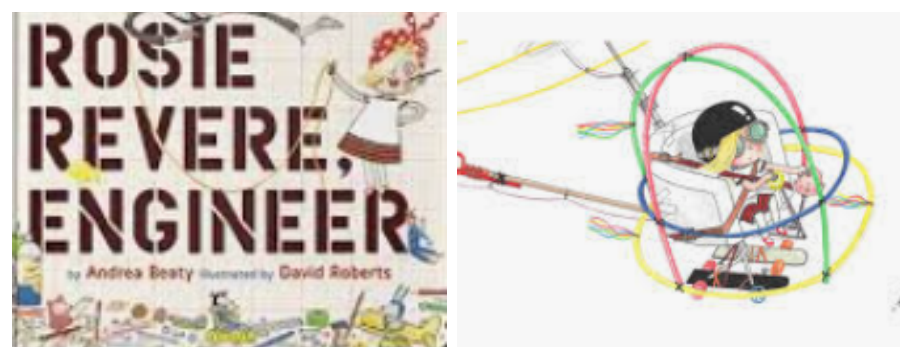
## SUMMER TERM 1

### WRITING

This half term, we will be exploring different genres including a narrative and writing to inform. Our English lessons will be designed to fully immerse the children in our engaging focus text '**Rosie Revere Engineer**'.

We will be writing an invention narrative as well as writing an explanation about how machines work..

Please do not read these books to your children as this will spoil the teaching sequence and excitement.



### HANDWRITING

We use letter join to teach the continuous cursive handwriting style; your child will be encouraged to use the correct letter formation with designated handwriting sessions during the week.

### READING

Over this half term we will continue encouraging children to read a variety of different genres and texts (not just their school reading books) and to develop a reading identity.

Please use the bookmarks sent home with children's reading books to discuss the text with them.

Each child will receive three books each week- a Reading Recovery book, or phonics book and a library book.

Books will be changed on a Monday providing they have read their books at least 3 times to focus on fluency, expression and comprehension. Your child's log must be signed at least 3 times.

If time permits please practise their reading words (in the back of their log) and writing the common exception words too.

### SPELLING/PHONICS

We will be focusing on learning Year 2 common exception words, prefixes/suffixes and spelling patterns.

### MATHS:

The units that will be covered this half term are:

- Fractions
- Time



At Ludworth maths is taught using a variety of methods. During maths lessons children have access to a variety of maths concrete resources to support their understanding of number and the four operations (+, -, x and ÷).

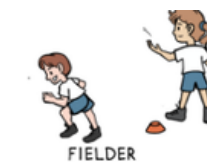
Children are encouraged to use these to aid them when completing maths work. Strong foundational knowledge is practised and taught daily through retrieval and Maths Mastery based sessions. This allows children to revisit prior learning and strengthen their understanding of number relationships.

We will continue to learn our 2,5,10 & 3 times tables.
