We are looking forward to continuing Year 4 learning with some exciting parts of the curriculum.

ENGLISH

We will continue to follow the Read2Write approach to teaching English. This half term we will focus on the text:

We will explore the text and create an invention narrative and a biography text.



MATHS

This units covered in Maths half term are:

Decimals, Money & Time

We will also be using Times Tables Rockstars, songs and games to practise times table facts.



DISCOVERY - HISTORY

This half term we will be learning about Living things and their habitats.

We will explore the digestive system, teeth, food chains and classifying animals.



SPELLING

Each week your child will learn a new phase or concept in their spelling lessons. This half term they will learn about: Words that are homophones, Words spelled with 'c' before 'i' and 'e', Words containing 'sol' and 'real', Words containing 'phon' and 'sign', Words with the prefixes 'super-', 'anti-' and 'auto', Words with the prefix 'bi-' meaning 'two'
