As we look ahead to our much-anticipated **Summer Fair – Ludworth Fest**, we would like to thank you in advance for your continued support.

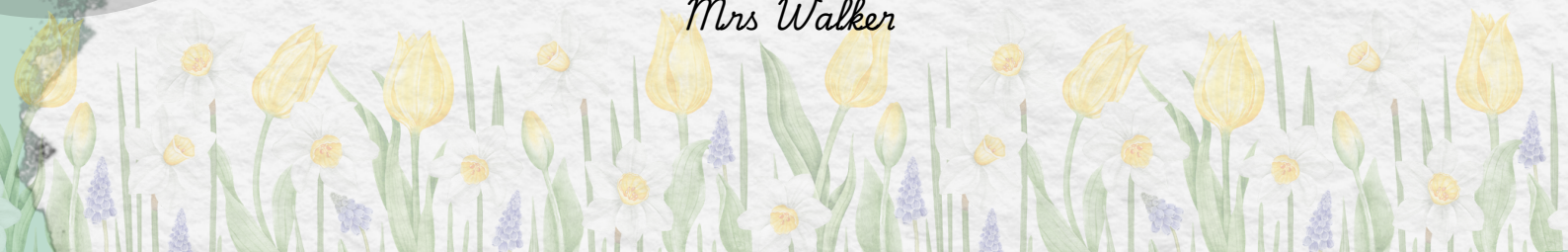

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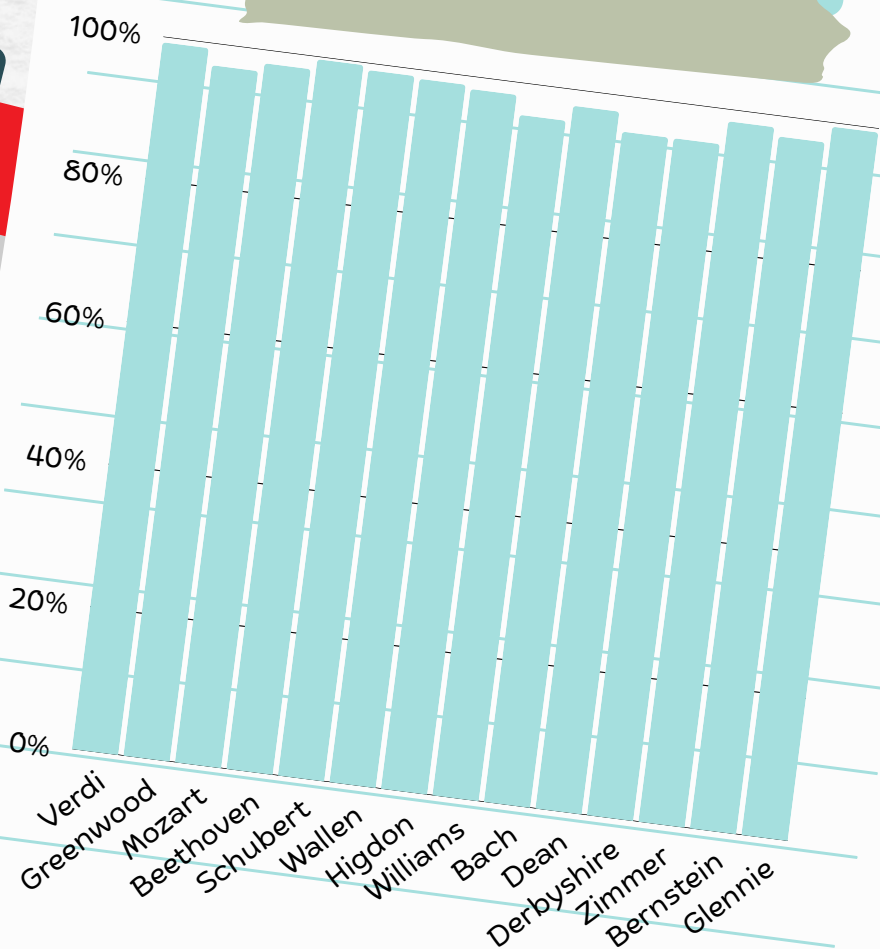
